TGR Team Green Racing recently had their Formula Xtreme competitor Mark Hatch exit in spectacular fashion at Mallala Raceway. Mark high sided the TGR ZX10R coming onto the final straight in qualifying resulting in a badly broken knee and ankle. The extent of the damage is so severe it has seen Mark with several screws into both parts of his leg and will unfortunately see him on the sidelines for the next couple of months.



Former Superbike privateer Steve Manning has been drafted in to replace the injured Mark Hatch and fly the Team Green flag from Winton onwards. Steve is a former winner of the class from 2005 and is looking forward to coming back and enjoying himself after having a years break from racing. "I cant wait to race the ZX10R and also race the new 08 model from Queensland as well, we had a positive first test at Wakefield Park on the 07 bike. The class looks great this year so I'm looking forward to the challenge." said Steve.

Mark said: "We called Steve as we are confident he will do well in this class. He will be on our 07 Zx10R for Winton and then he will race the new 2008 ZX10R from Queensland onwards. We were impressed at how quickly he got back up to speed at a recent test and were looking forward to Winton".
